one of the leading melon varieties in Japan. High brix (16-17%) and long shelf-life. Fruit size around 2.0 kg.



Honeymoon series:

Very sweet red flesh Japanese melon (Brix 16%). Good netting. Fruit size is 1.5 -1.8kg.



Pearl shower series:

High brix (16-17%) Japanese melon. Good netting. Fruit size 1.5-1.8kg. Tolerant to powdery mildew. Vigor plant.

Smiley series:

Seeded round type. Fruit size 8-10kg. High brix (11-12%). Good internal quality.



Ajinohimitsu series:

Seeded mini type. High brix (12-13%) and good internal quality.
